

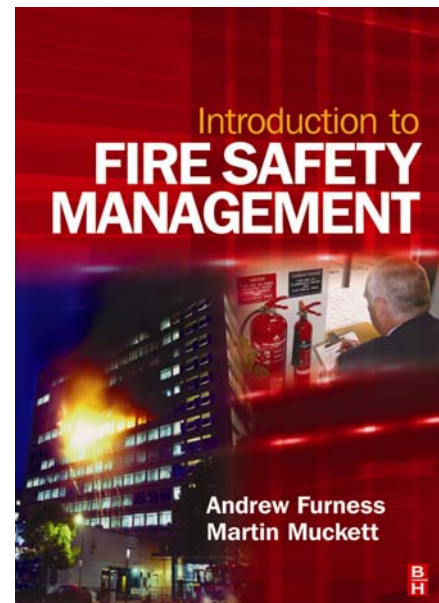


## Introduction to Fire Safety Management
